### Nationally Accredited Behavior Technician Level One Certificate Program (BTL1)

#### Overview of the Behavior Technician Level One Credential:

- Provides an alternative mechanism for credentialing entry level Behavior Technicians
- Nationally accredited by American National Standards Institute (ANSI)
- Onetime \$165 includes initial online 40 hours of ABA and Autism Coursework, final assessment and verification of 15 hours of fieldwork.
- All online and on demand 24/7
- Unlimited access to final assessment at no additional cost
- Significantly reduces costs related to onboarding new hires, initial training, certifying staff, multiple certification exam fees, turnover rates, and delay and even loss of billable services
- One on one support from our team to provider
- No contracts required
- No penalty or loss of fees for staff turnover within 30 days. We reopen that seat up for a new recruit
- Slashes time between point of hire to providing billable services while ensuring a qualified workforce. Typically 14 days or less
- Meets requisites for Washington CBT application and Oregon BARB application
- Accepted by major health plans in lieu of other certification including but not limited to the RBT
- Legally defensible thanks to the ANSI accreditation. Protects all stakeholders and better assures individuals and families are receiving timely services by qualified and credentialed staff.

#### Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be at least 18 yrs old
- Must have a minimum of a HS Diploma or equivalent

#### Program Completion Requirements:

- Recommendation (completed online) by immediate Supervisor (professor, teacher, mentor, work supervisor)
- Completion of 40 hours of coursework and instructional supports and probes at 90% criteria pass rate
- Complete four instructor-led exercises overseen by our BCBA-D
- Verification of a minimum of 15 hours of “on the job” training and demonstration of skills by a supervisor.
- Pass a standardized psychometrically sound final assessment. Required final assessment passing score: 72.80 %
- Complete online survey for continued quality assurance and management
- Agree to the Behavior Technician Code of Conduct and Ethics, Supervision Requirements and role of a BTL1
- Inclusion on the public registry as a source of primary source verification for third parties
